Here's what we are learning:

We learned about the /ur/ sound. You hear that sound in the words fur, her and bird.

We reviewed fantasy and reality. We call fantasy stories fiction. You call reality stories non-fiction.

We reviewed story elements. The characters are who or what the story is about. The plot is what happens in the story.

We worked on context clues. That is using the information in sentences and in pictures to determine the meaning of an unknown word.

We reviewed how to make inferences. That is when we use clues in the story and/or the pictures to figure out things the author wants us to know.

We reviewed how to summarize. That is when you write a sentence to tell about a story.

We learned about drawing conclusions.

We are learning how to tell time by 5-minute intervals.

We are learning about pennies, nickels, dimes and **quarters**. We need to be able to identify the coin, state its value and count a group of coins consisting of pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters and a combination of quarters, dimes, nickels, and pennies.

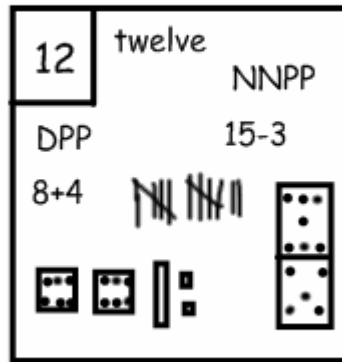
We practiced exchanging pennies for a nickel, nickels for a dime and pennies and a nickel for a dime.

We are showing a set amount of money two different ways with groups of coins.

We continue to review odd and even numbers. We know cheers to help us remember. **"0, 2, 4, 6 and 8. Being even is just great! 1, 3, 5, 7, 9. Being odd is just fine."**

We are learning about "function machines". They give us a rule that we need to follow. This is a fun way to practice our addition and subtraction facts.

We are learning how to name equivalent names for a number. For example, we can name 12 in the following ways:



We are learning about fractions.

We are learning about geometry.

We are learning about matter in science.

In social studies we are learning about American symbols.
