Here's what we are learning:

We reviewed blends and short vowel sounds.

We learned about story elements. The characters are who or what the story is about. The plot is what happens in the story.

We are learning how to break a story up into parts – the beginning, middle, and end.

We learned about the main idea of a story or picture.

We worked on context clues. That is using information in sentences and in pictures to determine the meaning of an unknown word.

In grammar, we learned that we must capitalize days of the week, months of the year, and holidays.

We are using a hundreds chart to count forwards and backwards.

We practiced counting to 100 by 1s & 2s and to 200 by 5s & 10s.

We practiced counting backwards from 20-0.

We are telling time to the hour. We are learning about half past the hour. We learned that on a digital clock, half past is written ":30."

We are learning about pennies and nickels. We need to be able to identify the coin, state its value and count a group of coins consisting of pennies, nickels, and a combination of nickels and pennies.

We are learning about patterns.

We continue to review odd and even numbers. We know cheers to help us remember. **"0, 2, 4, 6 and 8. Being even is just great! 1, 3, 5, 7, 9. Being odd is just fine."**

We learned how to use a number line to help us with addition and subtraction.

We are learning about living and non-living in science.

In social studies we are learning about voting.
