Here's what we are learning:

We reviewed the "sh" and the "th" sounds. We can hear those sounds in words like "ship," "wish," "thumb," and "this."

We reviewed the short vowel sounds of "a" and "i". We hear those sounds in words like "cat" and "pin."

We learned about the parts of a magazine.

We reviewed context clues. That is when we use the words in the sentence to help us figure out the meaning of a word.

We continue to work on sentences. We know that a sentence must be a complete thought. We begin a sentence with a capital letter and end it with a period.

We are using a hundreds chart to count forwards and backwards.

We practiced counting to 100 by 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s.

We practiced counting backwards from 20-0.

We are telling time to the hour.

We practiced stating numbers that were one more or one less than a given number.

We reviewed thermometers and practiced reading them to find the temperature.

We reviewed number stories (story problems) and how we can solve them. We practiced drawing pictures to show the story. We also practiced writing the number sentence that goes with the story.

We are learning about fire safety in science.

In social studies we are learning the six pillars of character.
