Here's what we are learning:

We learned that short "sh" sound can be heard in words like "ship" and "wish."

We reviewed that the "th" digraph has two sounds. We hear those sounds in "this" and "thumb."

We are learning about context clues. That is when we use the words in the sentence to help us figure out the meaning of a word.

We practiced using a picture dictionary.

We learned that a sentence must be a complete thought. We begin a sentence with a capital letter and end it with a period.

We continue to practice "hopping" on a number line.

We practiced counting to 100 by 1s, 5s, and 10s.

We practiced counting to 50 by 2s.

We practiced counting backwards from 20-0.

We practiced making tally marks and made "tally charts."

We practiced stating numbers that were one more or one less than a given number.

We reviewed thermometers and practiced reading them to find the temperature.

We learned about number stories (story problems) and how we can solve them. We practiced drawing pictures to show the story. We also practiced writing the number sentence that goes with the story.

We are learning about personal hygiene in science.

In social studies we are learning what it means to be a good citizen.
