

NCAA INITIAL-ELIGIBILITY – NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER:

In order to register with the NCAA Eligibility Center:

1. Go to the NCAA Eligibility Center Website: www.ncaaclearinghouse.net
2. Request that your high school guidance office submit a copy of at least six-semester transcript. This can be done by printing the NCAA Transcript Release Authorization form off of the NCAA Eligibility website and delivering it to the guidance office.
3. Send all ACT/SAT test scores to NCAA Eligibility Center directly from the testing agency. The ACT/SAT code that you would enter on the ACT/SAT registration form is 9999.
4. Answer the Amateurism questions at the NCAA Eligibility website. You will answer these questions with your initial submission and then you must log on to your account after April 1st of your senior year. At that time you must verify that these answers are still accurate. You then will sign off on this form. If you forget to log back on after April 1st of your senior year your eligibility will be affected.

1. The Margareta high school code is: 360825
2. The cost to the student for registering with the NCAA Eligibility Center is \$60.
3. It is suggested that students begin registering during their junior year.
4. College Acceptance and Athletic Eligibility are two separate entities. Students must be accepted in both areas to participate in sports.
