July 23, 2019 Margaretta Local Schools

Project funding options:

All locally funded

- Consensus of facility committee and community meetings
- Local control of design and process
- CM is not required
- LEED is not required
- Can proceed immediately, minimize construction cost inflation

OFCC - wait for CFAP (Classroom Facilities Assistance Program) funding

- No clear time when this could be available, could be 5+ years
 - No design or construction work until State funds are available
- State will pay a percentage of the project cost
 - Currently 35% State and 65% local
 - Will change every year in the future
 - Local share will likely increase as pipeline tax value increases district valuation
- OFCC is a co-owner
- OFCC will co-select your architect once the project is approved for funding
- OFCC approvals at each phase
- Longer timeline for design
- Must use Ohio School Design Manual and follow OFCC guidelines
- LEED required
- EDGE (minority and disadvantaged business program) required

OFCC - ELPP (Expedited Local Partnership Program)

- Margaretta will need to formally apply to the ELPP program
 - Determine OFCC Master Plan
 - Enrollment projection updates
 - OFCC formally approves the Master Plan before you can begin
 - May take 6-12 month to get through the ELPP approval process
- District pays for the project now with a promise of State co-funding in the future
 - State/Local % will lock in at the time the ELPP agreement is approved by OFCC
 - Currently 35% State and 65% local. Equity number and % share changes in September 2019
 - ELPP approval will likely not occur before September 2019
 - Local share will likely increase as pipeline tax value increases district valuation
- OFCC is a co-owner
- Longer timeline for design
- Must use Ohio School Design Manual and follow OFCC guidelines
- LEED required

Design

- 100% custom?
- Utilize an existing building as a conceptual prototype
 - Existing buildings will not have the same program and size so modifications will be necessary

Non-OFCC design process time

- May be able to reduce design phase by 2-3 months due to reduced phase approval time and/or utilizing an existing building design as a concept for planning
- Construction Time

For 6-12 building
 For K-12 building
 Approx. 18-20 months
 Approx. 20-24 months

- Ideal start time for efficient construction is early spring
- Later starts may extend construction time needed
- Potential completion date for 6-12 building
 - Assuming August 1, 2019 design start
 - Break Ground between May 2020 and September 2020
 - Estimated occupancy between January 2022 and May 2022
- Potential completion date for K-12 building
 - Assuming August 1, 2019 design start
 - Break Ground between May 2020 and September 2020
 - Estimated occupancy between March 2022 and July 2022



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Project Delivery methods

General Contracting

- Traditional design/bid/build
- Publicly bid to a single general contractor who will hold contract with the district

Multiple Prime Contracting

- Traditional design/bid/build
- The project is broken down into multiple bid packages
- Publicly bid to multiple contractors who will each hold contract with the district
- Can hire a CM or owner's agent to help manage the project
- Was the method used for the first 15 years of OFCC

CM at Risk

- CM is selected as the builder and single point of contract
- CM provides a price to build the building.
- Costs are generally higher than design/bid/build options

Design Build

- District hires a criteria design architect for conceptual/schematic design
- District then hires a design-builder (D-B) to execute the design
- (D-B) provides a price to build the building
- D-B is at risk to provide the design intent at a fixed price. Consequently the Owner has less control and input into the design materials and equipment.
