Mid-late February 2024: Students will turn in scheduling and other forms to their counselors. **NOTE: this timeline is subject to change.

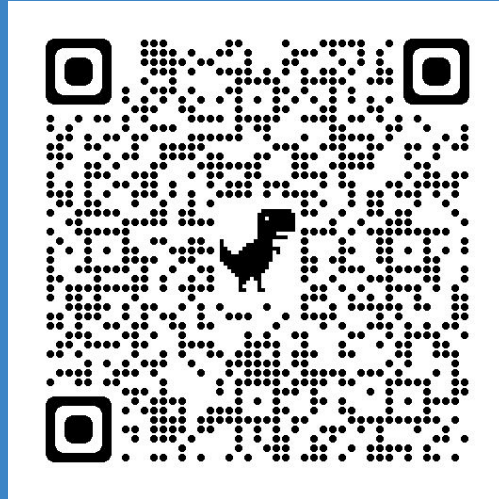

Guide-complete and turn into Student Services
 - Qualifying sport or activity waives PE; need to qualify in 2 separate school years

Qualifying activities: Sports, Powerlifting, Cheerleading, Dance Team, Marching Band

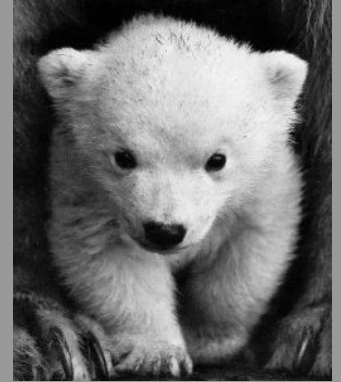

Our middle school will offer career exploration classes (STEM/STEAM) to expand their knowledge of what they are interested in and what they wish to explore by having 100% of our freshmen to explore at least one career/ workplace study experience.

Career Based Intervention

CBI

CBI is a career-tech program for students in grades 7-12 and identified as disadvantaged.

- 2018-2019 CBI brought back to MHS - 11 students
- 2019-2020 - 18 students
- 2020-2021 - 24 students
- 2021-2022 - 22 students
- 2022-2023 - 22 students
- 2023-2024 - 24 students
